

**INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION OF
CARNEYS POINT TOWNSHIP
MEETING MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 14, 2020**

The meeting of the Carneys Point Industrial Commission was held on the above date at the time of **6:35 p.m.** Mr. Brayerton called the meeting to order; read the **Open Public Meeting Act** and led the **Salute to the Flag**.

Roll call was taken; Brayerton, Bryant, Johnson, Redfield and Wright were present. Mr. Fahr and Mr. O'Donald were not in attendance. Also present was J. Proffitt-Secretary. A Quorum was established.

Mr. Brayerton gave a reminder to everyone that the next meeting will be on November 9th. The meeting for October 12th is on a holiday and the building will be closed. Mr. Brayerton asked everyone to take a moment to review the minutes from the Special Commission meeting held on June 29, 2020. Mr. Redfield made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Mr. Bryant. A unanimous vote was taken.

With no **Correspondence** to report on Mr. Brayerton moved on to **Old Business**. Mr. Redfield brought up the website for the Industrial Commission. He said in his opinion the Commission and Township are throwing their money down a drain. Mr. Brayerton mentioned receiving a message from the Finance Office on the current company we are paying for our hosting the site does not have a NJ Business Registration. That could get the Township an audit review if not corrected. Mr. Brayerton said he spoke to Mrs. Jones in the Finance Office about the Townships website. He asked if they could add our pages to that site. She was going to look into that for him. If it can be done, he is thinking of dropping our site. Mr. Redfield said our site was supposed to help bring business to this area. He said without the website business is now coming on its own so why are we paying for a site that is not functioning. Mr. Brayerton said he will have answers by the November meeting.

Mr. Brayerton mentioned that Committeeman Bomba sent him some paperwork on Site and Facility Planning, Infrastructure Investment as an Economic Stimulus Tool. He asked the Secretary to make copies for everyone for the next meeting.

Mr. Brayerton mentioned that this is the time to sell property. He said he was told people are leaving the cities to come to the country. Mr. Redfield said this is a hot spot.

Mr. Brayerton spoke on showing support to the Township Committees and Commissions. He said currently all meetings are through teleconference. He said go on and listen, see how you can show support for businesses coming to our Township.

Bill List for approval. Mr. Wright approved the bill list, seconded by Ms. Johnson and all were in favor.

Public participation. With no comments or questions this portion was closed.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Ms. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Redfield to adjourn. Motion passed with five affirmative votes. Meeting adjourned at 7:01 pm.
